It is hard to believe that we are beginning our last month and a half of the school year! We are already in the process of planning for next year. Registration for the 2010-2011 school year will take place at Algonquin Road School on May 26th from 3:00-8:00 PM and June 1st from 8:00AM – 3:00PM for all students ECE through 8th grade. Registration forms are sent home in advance to expedite the registration process. K-7th grade registration fee is \$130 and the 8th grade fee will be \$165 (including graduation fee). Gym uniforms may be purchased for 5th-8th graders - \$6 for shirts and \$9 for shorts with a separate check from registration.
